

Native American Diorama



Directions: You will create a shoe box diorama based on the American Indian tribe you have been researching in Social Studies. Your diorama will realistically portray and be graded on the following:

- *the natural geography of the region of your tribe (desert, forest, plains, etc.) 15 points,
- *the food your tribe ate (fish, deer, corn, etc.) 15 points,
- *the type of housing structure your tribe lived in (wigwam, tipi, etc.) 15 points,
- *examples of the types of tools and utensils used and made by your tribe (baskets, pottery, weapons, etc.) 15 points,
- *examples of the types of clothing worn by your tribe (both men and women) 15 points,
- *neatness & key (label each category within the diorama and create a key) 10 points, and
- *creativity & title (title the diorama with the region your diorama depicts) 15 points.
