Writing a Paragraph on Theme

- 1. Use the SIFT Method when reading the text to help you analyze the theme.
- 2. Your topic sentence for the paragraph should include the title, the author, and the theme.
- 3. Use evidence from the text to support the theme. You may use quotes and paraphrasing.
- 4. Explain how your evidence reveals the theme of the text.
- 5. Use **transition** phrases between the evidence and the explanations to connect your ideas.
- 6. Make a connection between the theme of the text and real life.
 Use phrases like the following to make the connection stronger:
 a. Just like in the story.
 b. As you can see.
- 7. Restate the theme to summarize.

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
