

## Writing a Paragraph on Theme

1. Use the **SIFT** Method when reading the text to help you analyze the theme.
2. Your topic sentence for the paragraph should include the title, the author, and the theme.
3. Use **evidence** from the text to support the theme. You may use quotes and paraphrasing.
4. Explain **how** your evidence reveals the theme of the text.
5. Use **transition** phrases between the evidence and the explanations to connect your ideas.
6. Make a **connection** between the theme of the text and real life. Use phrases like the following to make the connection stronger:
  - a. Just like in the story. . .
  - b. As you can see. . .
7. Restate the theme to summarize.

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
