1. **Restate** the question as the topic sentence. Do not include any details.
2. Provide an **answer** to the question.
3. Use **evidence** from the text to support your answer. You may use quotes and paraphrasing. Be sure to quote accurately and include the page number. The more evidence, the stronger your answer.
4. **Explain** how your evidence supports your answer.
5. Use **transition** phrases to connect your evidence and your explanations back to your answer.
6. **Summarize** your position.
